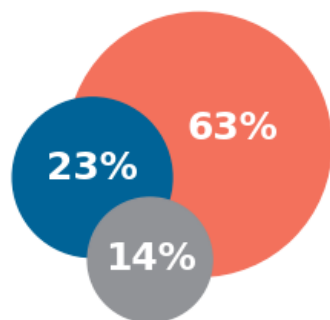


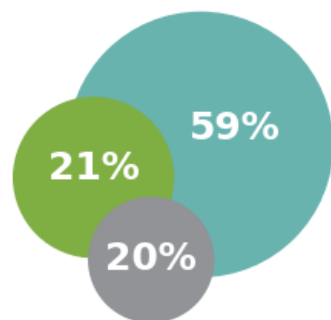

Conservation: Projects at Jordan Lake (Important Bird Area); support for invasive plant research at NCCU; habitat improvement projects in collaboration with NC Botanical Gardens, Durham Parks Foundation, and Eno River Association.

Education: Programs for local schools, libraries, teachers, and the public.

Chapter expenses: Media and communications, Board member training
